Intro:- *Echo*

4 Claps- **Front Row** walking forward only

4 Claps- **Back Row** only

4 Claps In a Z (up L, up R, down L, down R)- **Front Row** only

4 Claps In a Z (up L, up R, down L, down R)- **Back Row** only

2 Fleaflickers lt & rt - **Front Row** only dbl up-ds dbl up-ds

2 Fleaflickers lt & rt - **Back Row** only dbl up-ds dbl up-ds

Everyone- 4 ds-brush up (turn L in a box)

Part A:

1 Mountain Goat

4 dbl steps ds-ds (xif)-ds (turn 1/4 R)- ds (ib)

1 Charleston (facing side)

2 Basics (with claps) ds (turn 1/4 to front)- r (ots) s ds-r (ots) s

2 Karates ds-karate kick (turn 1/2 L)-ds-brush up

2 Push-offs (with claps left & right)

Part B:

3 Kentucky drag w/Basic (moving L)

Cowboy

Repeat other direction

Part C:

3 Slur step w/Basic (moving L) ds-slur step- ds-slur step- ds-slur step-ds-rs

Samantha

Repeat other direction

Part D:

2 ds-ds-ds-stomp-stomp (front two lines pass through each other)

2 rockers rs (turn 1/4 R)-ds-ds-rs rs (turn 1/4 R)-ds-ds-rs

2 ds-ds-ds-stomp-stomp (same two lines pass back through each other)

2 rockers rs (turn 1/4 R)-ds-ds-rs rs (turn 1/4 R)-ds-ds-rs

Part E:

Turning clogover ds-ds (xif)- ds-ds (turn 1/2 R)- ds (turn 1/2 R)- ds (xif)-ds-rs

2 Fontana's ds-dbl (xif)- dbl (out)- rs

Repeat other direction

End:

2 ds-ds-ds-stomp-stomp (1st Set Back row move forward to make 1 row, 2nd Set everybody Move Forward

High Horse ⁽³⁶⁰⁾ DS DT(xif) DT(os) RS R Hitch DS (SLOW) DS RS

Big Finish SLOW Step Left turn 1/2 face back, Step Left 1/4 turn rt(Facing Stage rt). Doing a wave formation, Right arm down Left arm up in angle. Wait then the end person Cross Rt over Lt 3/4 turn face front Wave formation, Once everyone done 1/4 turn Lt and walk off stage Hands high in the air.
